- **Regulate** the Inland/Inshore Diving Supervisors Scheme

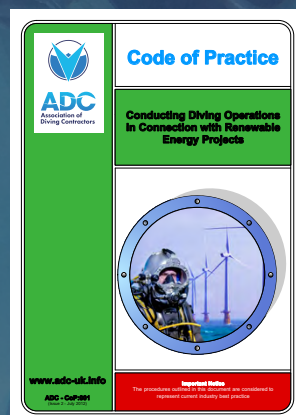
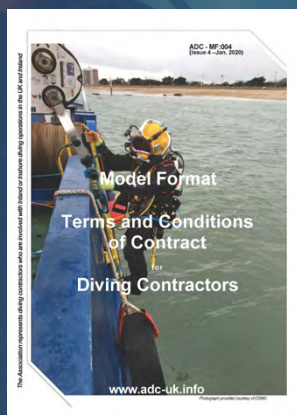
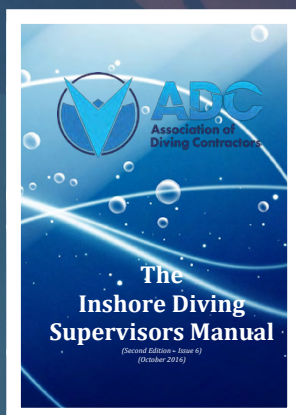
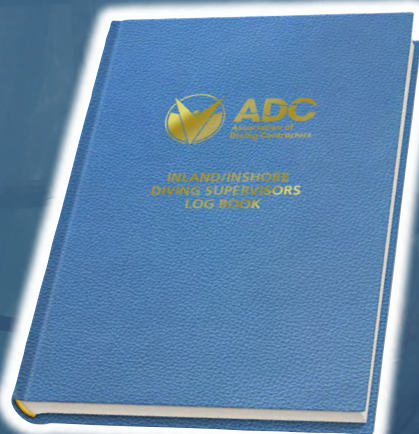
